


Manure Management Plan Shell Rock Valley Landscapes, LLC (Finisher #2)

This report is to make you aware of concerns regarding a Manure Management Plan Annual Update received by this office from Shell Rock Valley Landscapes, LLC (Finisher #2) formerly H.E. Trettin, Inc. Finisher #2 swine operation. This report is being submitted according to Resolution 2003-123 A Resolution Adopting Policy for the Receipt, Review and Comment on Manure Management Plans Received by the Cerro Gordo County Board of Supervisors. Within seven (7) days of receipt of the manure management plan the Environmental Service Manager shall review the Manure Management Plan and prepare a report to the Board of Supervisors detailing the issues to forward to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources.

The confinement unit is an existing operation that has <u>changed ownership</u>; however, it is not expanding. The operation is located on the Floyd-Cerro Gordo County line at **2256 Zinnia Avenue**, Rockford, Iowa in <u>Floyd County</u>. The capacity of the facility is 3,950 hogs (four finishing barns) with two production cycles per year. The 1,730,100 gallons of annual manure production is a dramatic increase from the previous owner's 377,354 gallons. The manure is stored in <u>earthen</u> structures. <u>The plan list two fields totaling 234.3 acres</u>; this compares to the preceding plan for this operation of nine (9) fields totaling 437.4 acres. The two fields are in Sections 25 and 36 of Owen Township. The concerns with the plan are listed below:

- Bird Hill Fossil Preserve is about 1½ mile from the manure application area.
- A grassy waterway cuts across the field in Section 25 of Owen Township.
- Manure production increased from 377,354 to 1,730,100 for no apparent reason.
- Manure is stored in an earthen structure.
