

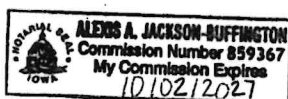

SUBJECT: Manure Management Plan for Indigo Family Farms (Ashley's Farm)

This report is to make you aware of concerns regarding a Manure Management Plan Update received by this office from Indigo Family Farms (Ashley's Farm) swine operation. This report is being submitted according to Resolution 2003-123 A Resolution Adopting Policy for the Receipt, Review and Comment on Manure Management Plans Received by the Cerro Gordo County Board of Supervisors. Within seven (7) days of receipt of the manure management plan the Environmental Service Manager shall review the Manure Management Plan and prepare a report to the Board of Supervisors detailing the issues to forward to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources.

The confinement unit is located at **3160 Wood Avenue in Section 14 of Ellington Township in Hancock County** about three miles west of the Cerro Gordo-Hancock County line. The swine operation is an existing operation that is not expanding. The operation consists of 3,400 hogs which will produce about 1,058,007 gallons of manure annually. The manure application area consists of eight fields totaling 875.8 acres. Six fields of 658.2 acres are in Hancock County, whereas two fields consisting of 217.6 acres are in Sections 7 and 18 of Grant Township, Cerro Gordo County. **The fields on which manure will be applied are unchanged from the previous plan.** The concerns are listed below:

- Several public use lands are near the manure application area: Haugen Wildlife Area is ¼ mile, Kuhn Wildlife Area is ½ mile, Wild Goose Marsh WMA two miles, Teal Basins WPA 1½ miles, Sandpiper Hills WPA adjacent, Mallard Marsh ½ mile, Winnebago Oxbow one mile, Hansen Wildlife Area 1½ miles, Otter Bend Wildlife Area ¼ mile, and Prairie Pothole Wildlife Area one mile.
- There is a waterway (which is a tributary of the Winnebago River) that cuts across the field in Section 18 of Grant Township
