January 26, 2026

The Board of Supervisors of Cerro Gordo County, Iowa, met in regular session pursuant to adjournment. Present: Chairman Casey Callanan, Vice Chairman Carl Ginapp, Supervisor Chris Watts, and various members of the public.

Watts moved with Ginapp seconding, to approve claims. Motion passed unanimously.

Watts moved with Ginapp seconding, to authorize the Chair to sign Agreement for Drainage District Watchperson Services with Bolton & Menk. Motion passed unanimously.

Ginapp moved with Watts seconding, to adopt Resolution 2026-16, A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR AN APPLICATION THROUGH THE BETTER UTILIZING INVESTMENTS TO LEVERAGE DEVELOPMENT (BUILD) GRANT PROGRAM FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE HIGHWAY 122/4TH STREET SW CORRIDOR IN THE CITY OF MASON CITY, IOWA

WHEREAS, the City of Mason City has made an application for grant funding to the Department of Transportation for much needed improvements to the Highway 122/4th Street SE corridor in the City of Mason City for the purpose of safe and efficient travel, and WHEREAS, the City has taken the first step by preparing a Feasibility Report that provides proposed improvements to reduce accidents and provide a safe route for walkers and bicyclers; and WHEREAS, this project demonstrates a comprehensive approach to making this corridor safer for all users; and WHEREAS, the improved roadway will foster growth and will be a benefit to our community as a whole by prioritizing the well-being of its citizens and visitors; and NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cerro Gordo County Board of Supervisors, Cerro Gordo County, Iowa:

Section 1: that the Cerro Gordo County Board hereby supports the application by the City of Mason City for grant funding through the Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) Grant Program from the Department of Transportation for improvements to the Highway 122/4th Street SW Corridor in the City of Mason City, Iowa. Motion passed unanimously.

Watts moved with Ginapp seconding, to approve the manure management plan update from the Environmental Health Service Manager for Amarcon Red Barn (site #65072) and forward to DNR. Motion passed unanimously.

County Engineer Brandon Billings provided an update.

Ginapp moved with Watts seconding, to approve the Soil Correction Project Design and Construction Inspection Agreement for the Road Maintenance Building Project in Rockwell with Veentstra & Kimm in the amount of \$185,000. Motion passed unanimously.

Ginapp moved with Watts seconding, to adjourn at 10:09 a.m. Motion passed unanimously.
