

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
August 17, 2026

The Board of Supervisors of Cerro Gordo County, Iowa, met in regular session pursuant to adjournment. Present: Chairman Casey Callanan, Vice Chairman Carl Ginapp, Supervisor Chris Watts, and various members of the public.

Chairman Callanan convened the meeting at 10:00 a.m.

Ginapp moved with Watts seconding, to approve today's agenda and the minutes of the August 10, 2026 regular session. Motion passed unanimously.

Public comment session was held.

Watts moved with Ginapp seconding, to approve claims. Motion passed unanimously.

Ginapp moved with Watts seconding to authorize the Chair to sign the NIACOG Local Intergovernmental Review Consultation form for the USDA Rural Development Housing Preservation grant. Motion passed unanimously.

County Engineer Brandon Billings provided an update.

Watts moved with Ginapp seconding, to adopt Resolution 2026-58, WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Cerro Gordo, Iowa, is authorized by Chapter 321 of the Code of Iowa and Chapter 321.245 of Iowa Code; and WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the interest of public safety, traffic regulation, and the control of all vehicles approaching said intersection to alter the current traffic control setup; and WHEREAS, a traffic review or engineering consideration has recommended that the intersection of 150th Street and Yarrow Avenue be designated as Yield intersection. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Cerro Gordo, Iowa: Section 1. That a YIELD sign shall be erected, maintained, and enforced for the regulation and control of traffic approaching and entering the intersection as follows: [Example: A Yield sign on the north side of 150th Street at the intersection with Yarrow Avenue, regulating southbound traffic]. Section 2. That any existing conflicting traffic control devices, such as [Example: the existing Stop sign], shall be removed upon installation of the new yield sign(s). Section 3. That the County Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to procure, erect, and maintain said YIELD sign in accordance with the specifications outlined in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) as adopted by the State of Iowa. Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval, and execution by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, and upon the physical installation of the authorized signage. Motion passed unanimously.

Ginapp moved with Watts seconding, to adopt Resolution 2026-59, WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Cerro Gordo, Iowa, is authorized by Chapter 321 of the Code of Iowa and Chapter 321.245 of Iowa Code; and WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the interest of public safety, traffic regulation, and the control of all vehicles approaching said intersection to alter the current traffic control setup; and WHEREAS, a traffic review or engineering consideration has recommended that the intersection of 310th Street and Eagle Avenue be designated as 4-way stop intersection. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Cerro Gordo, Iowa: Section 1. That a 4-way STOP sign installation shall be erected, maintained, and enforced for the regulation and control of traffic approaching and entering the intersection as follows: [Example: A Stop sign on the north and South side of 310th Street at the intersection with Eagle Avenue, regulating southbound and northbound traffic]. Section 2. That any existing conflicting traffic control devices, shall be removed upon installation of the new stop sign(s). Section 3. That the County Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to procure, erect, and maintain said STOP signs in accordance with the specifications outlined in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) as adopted by the State of Iowa. Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval, and execution by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, and upon the physical installation of the authorized signage. Motion passed unanimously.

Ginapp moved with Watts seconding, to adjourn at 10:12 a.m. Motion passed unanimously.
